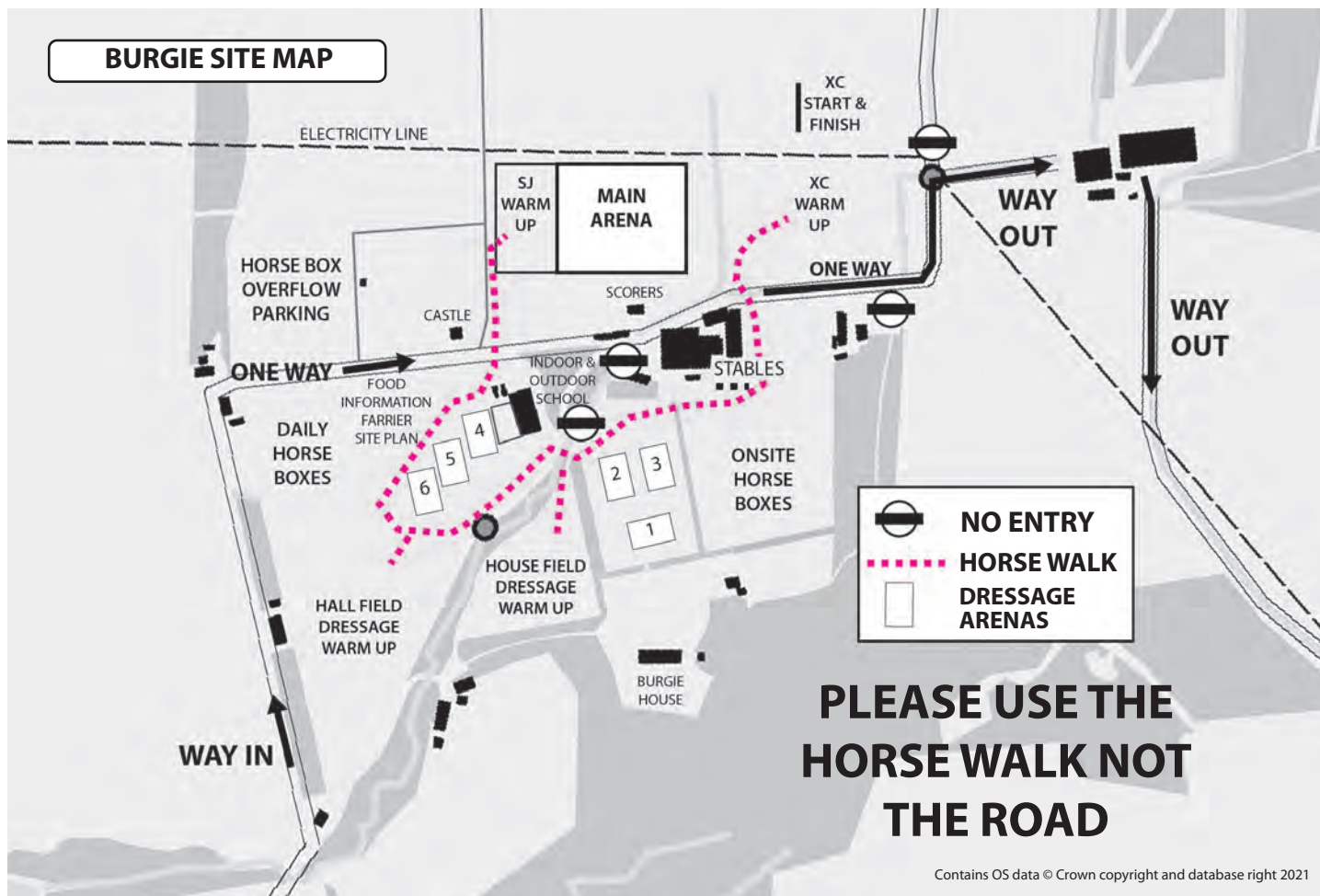

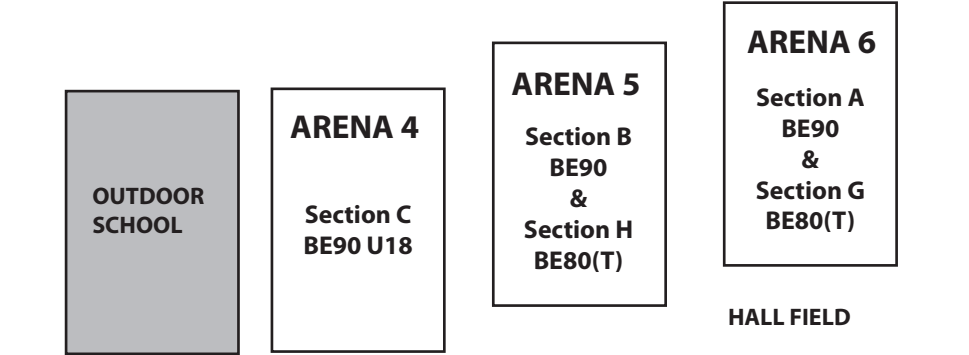
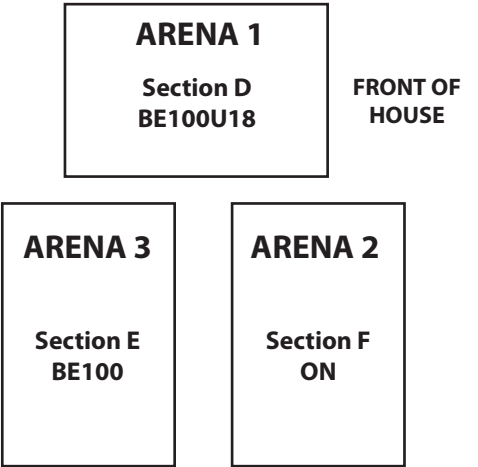

DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Except for the negligence of the Organisers and their agents or others for whom in law they are responsible, the Organiser does not accept responsibility in respect of any accident, illness or disease caused to or suffered by any horse, owner, competitor, spectator, sponsor and others present at the site of the Event and their property and accoutrements.

REPORTING TO A DOCTOR

Any competitor who has had a fall at the Horse Trial must be seen by one of the Doctors and be passed fit to ride before riding that horse in another test or before riding another horse.

FORBIDDEN ASSISTANCE

Any intervention by a third party, whether solicited or not, with the object of facilitating the task of the rider or helping his or her horse, is forbidden, under penalty of elimination, at the discretion of the BE Steward. In particular, it is forbidden to call back or assist a competitor by directions to rectify an error of course.

MOTORBIKES AND ALL-TERRAIN VEHICLES

The use of motorbikes and all-terrain vehicles is banned except for authorised officials. Anyone found riding a motorbike or all-terrain vehicle without permission will be asked to leave the event.

UNACCOMPANIED COMPETITORS

Unaccompanied competitors must provide the Secretary with a contact telephone number in case of emergency.

HEALTH AND SAFETY

The Organisers of this event have taken reasonable precautions to ensure the health and safety of everyone present.

For these measures to be effective, everyone must take all reasonable precautions to prevent accidents and must comply with any instructions given by the Organiser, Officials and Stewards.

All horses on the field including companion horses must be issued with a number from the secretary.

Any mounted rider must be wearing relevant number to horse ridden.

The use of motorbikes and all-terrain vehicles is banned except for authorised officials.

Anyone found riding a motorbike or all-terrain vehicle without permission will be asked to leave the event.

Spectators must use Crossing Points, watch out for horses, listen for whistles and control children.

The Organisers of the event advise that due to the uneven surface, and in parts irregular territory, it may be difficult for spectators to move around freely and easily, as a result of which the area covered by the event may not be suited for those who suffer medical conditions. All spectators enter this event at their own risk and are advised to wear suitable footwear. Organisers will not incur any liability except as required by law.

RESERVATION OF RIGHT:

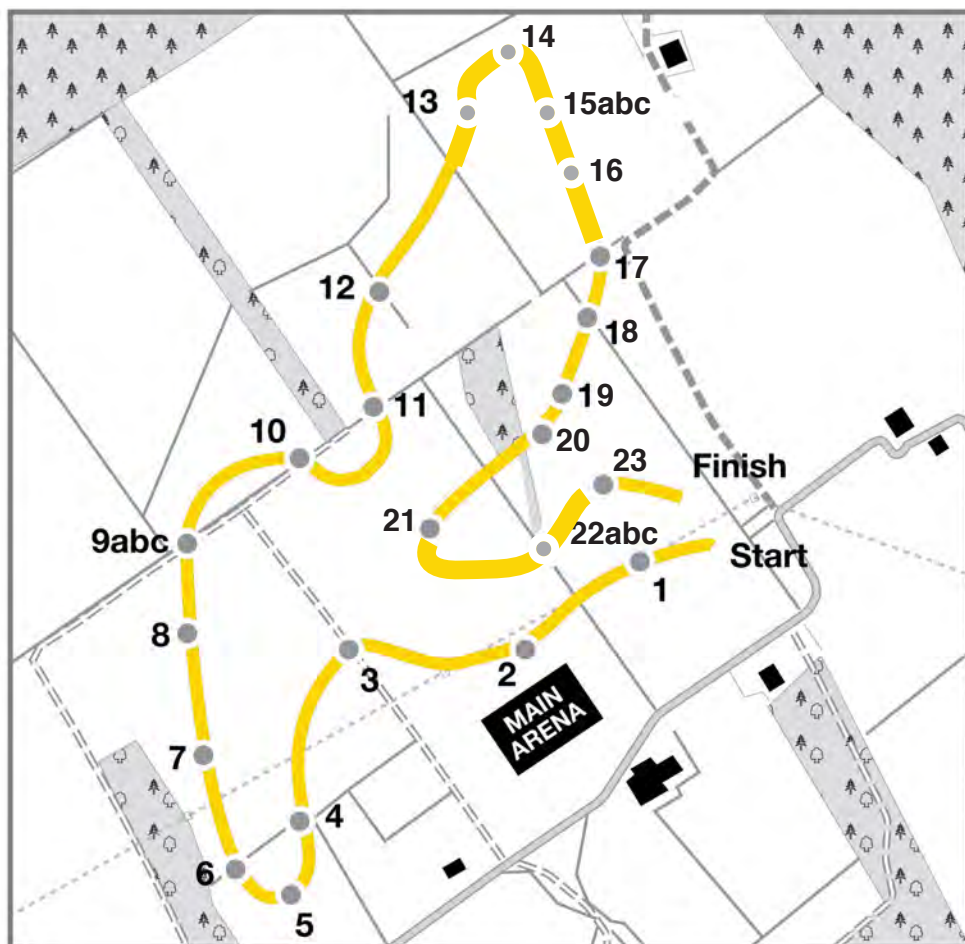
The organiser has the right

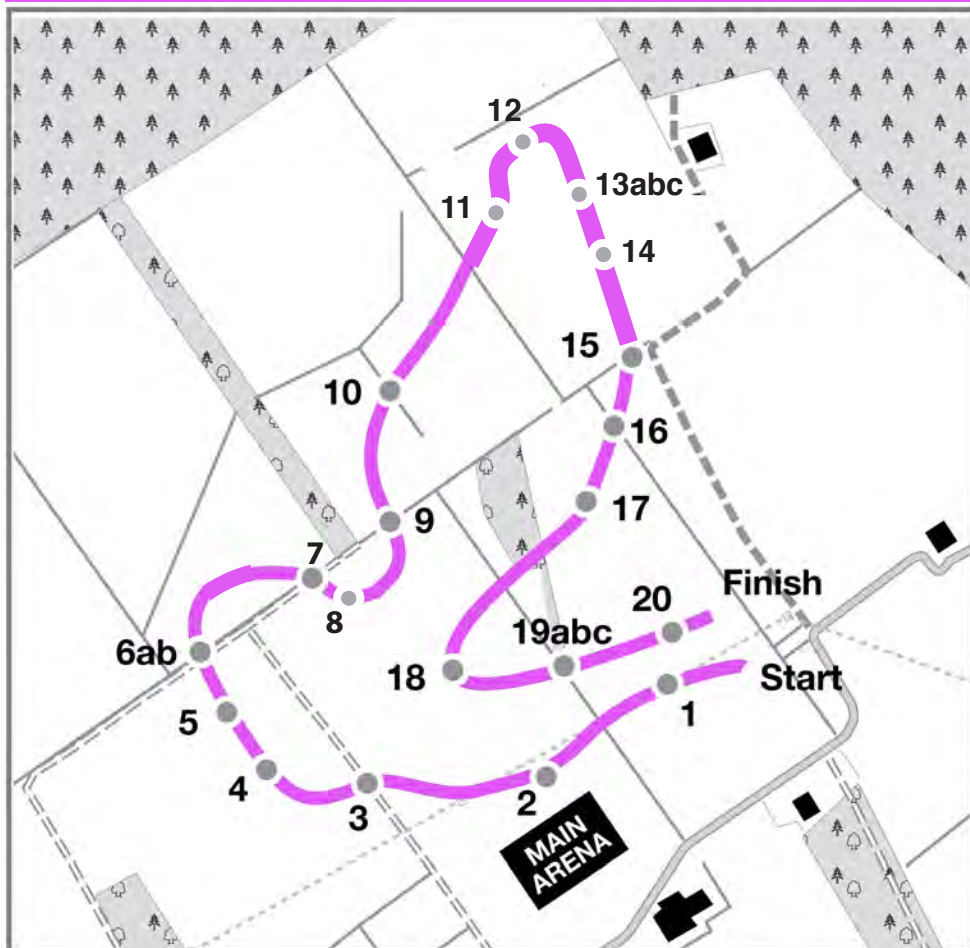

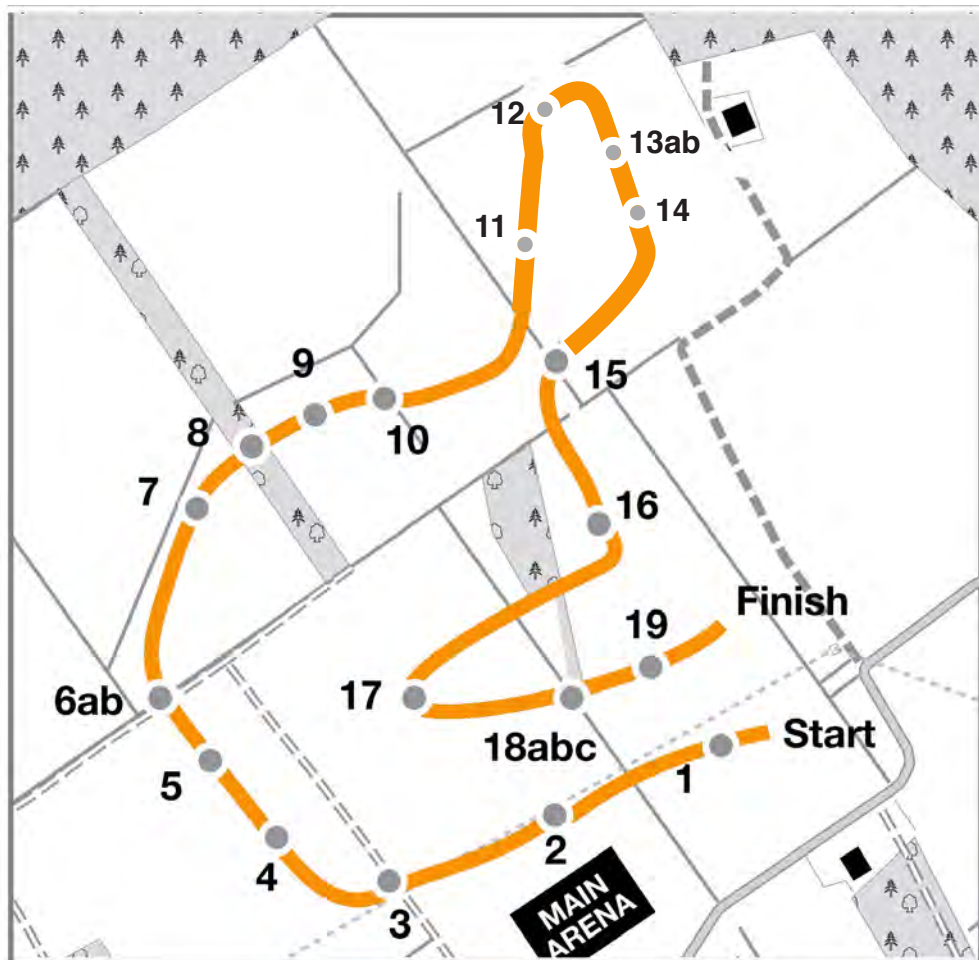
